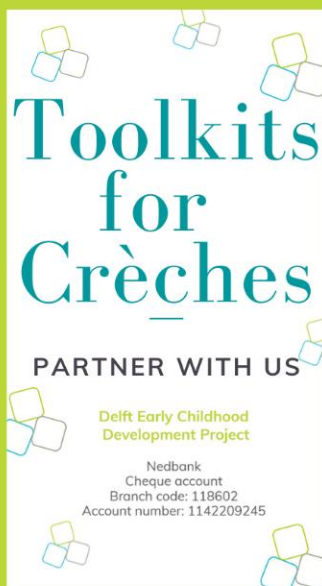

Toolkit Campaign:

As part of the AmazingBrainz curriculum training, we supply every educator with a Toolkit containing every resource she requires to teach and develop her class effectively. From educational toys, posters, books, etc. you name it, the toolkit contains it. Each toolkit costs R3800 per kit. We have launched a campaign asking for support from individuals and organisations to donate the cost of one or a few boxes. We are delighted that people have started to respond to our campaign, and we trust that we will have collected the total amount by February. There are few opportunities to donate that have such a lasting and significant positive impact on a community as these toolkits have in the hands of well-trained educators.
