Not only did the lockdown again have an immense effect on their schools' attendance and finances, but it also limited Amazing Brainz to continue with the training in person. However, weekly virtual support was given in creative ways and the teachers could continue to give feedback on the execution of the school activities via WhatsApp. The teachers proved their resilience and by the grace of God all the schools could remain open.

We are extremely grateful for the incredible partnership between Shofar and Amazing Brainz over the last three years. The credible fruit of their work, love and dedication are evident in the schools. Phrases from the teachers like, "I was disorganized, but now I'm organized" or "The training is making my life as a principal so much easier" confirming the success of this project. The decision to take on a new group of educators was obvious due to the big success and demand after the first intake. 43 ECD centers applied for the second project, where 20 ECD centers and 75 educators were selected to take part in the second training. We are elated to walk a road with the precious new group of educators which started in August.
